Curriculum Update

Lesson 25*: "Betrayal by Judas" through "Peter's Denial"

Judas was a thief and took money from the treasury of the disciples. He allowed his greed to become so strong that he was even willing to betray Jesus for money. He went to the chief priests and asked, "How much will you give me to betray Jesus to you?" When they heard that, they were glad and they counted out thirty pieces of silver to him. From that moment on, Judas sought for an opportunity to betray Jesus to them.

When the time had come to eat the Passover on Thursday evening, Jesus was at the table with the disciples. He sadly said, "Truly, I say to you that one of you will betray Me." Of course, that was shocking to the disciples and they each began to ask Him, "Lord, is it I?" But Jesus only said that it was necessary that this should happen to Him to fulfill the scriptures, but that it would have been better for the traitor if he had never been born. Even Judas asked Him, "Lord, is it I?" Jesus said to him, you said so, and He sent him away to do what he needed to do.

Jesus said to the disciples that before the night was over, they would all forsake Him, leaving Him to be mocked and crucified by His enemies, and that Peter would deny Him three times. They went to the Garden of Gethsemane, also known as the Mount of Olives. They all fell asleep, including Peter. Judas came with the officers from the Jewish Temple, not the Romans. They grabbed Jesus to arrest Him.

Jesus was showing us that obedience to God is not always easy. Sometimes it is very difficult and even dangerous, but if we love Him and have faith, we will always do what He asks of us.
