Curriculum Update

Lesson 29*: The Ascension

Now the time had come for Jesus to leave the disciples. He had come into the world to bring the Word of God. He had carefully taught and prepared them for three years to carry on with the work of God. He had spent the last 40 days with them and only them, He did not return to the multitudes, no miracles or healings were performed, He appeared 11 times and only to the 11 disciples privately. He led them to a mountain outside Jerusalem and He gave them what is now called "The Great Commission." He gave them a mission, to go out and baptize all nations. When the 40 days were complete, they asked, "Lord, is now the time you're going to restore the Kingdom of Israel?" He told them only the Father knows this; it's not for you to know but for you to live. And He instructed them to go to Jerusalem and wait there to receive the promise and the power from the Holy Spirit. Then He blessed them and disappeared. His father took Him up. The disciples told others, and we are all to trust in God based on what we are taught and told that was passed down to us from the disciples through the Church. The time of teaching begins with Ascension, and judgment day is the final exam to see if we learned and applied the teaching. When He comes back, He will judge.



The number 4 means universality, and the magnification of 4 is 40. So, 40 days of teaching them after the resurrection shows a lengthy time of teaching and preaching to prepare them for their work and ministry to the whole world. Similar to the 40 days in the desert before Jesus went out into His ministry. To shed the old and be ready for the new. The way the Israelites were forced to roam in the desert for 40 years, to show the death of one generation and the birth of a new one.
